### HERE'S WHY...

The **Voluntary Insurance** facility allows you the option of maintaining your contribution payments during periods of unemployment, through the payment of **Voluntary Contributions**.

This facility is available to persons who were previously engaged in insurable employment; are no longer employed; have not reached retirement age and who wish to continue contributing to NI to qualify for, or enhance the retirement benefit.
